Kuras, Rev. Alexander, passed on from this life on July 1, 2013 at the age 70. Father Kuras was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Detroit on June 7, 1969. Father Kuras' assignments included serving as associate pastor at St. James Parish, Ferndale and Holy Name Parish, Birmingham. In addition Father Kuras served as pastor at Our Lady of the Lakes Parish, Waterford, and Divine Savior Parish, Westland. Father Kuras was predeceased by his parents Max and Anastasia and brother Daniel. He is survived by his aunts Helen Polanski and Rose Kuras, and nephews Craig, Dan, Kevin and many cousins.
