It is with profound sorrow that we announce the passing of Brenda Faye Adcox Norman. As we gather in memory, we find comfort in the extraordinary journey she shared with us.

Brenda was the youngest and last surviving of the six children of Raleigh Raymond Adcox and Geneva King Adcox. She grew up in Northville, MI. Brenda is survived by her children, Kelly Norman (1962), Kathleen Scanlan (Daniel) (1964), Kimberly Stripling (Michael) (1967) and John Michael Norman (1974); grandchildren Quinn Norman, Hollie Taylor (Jonathan), Amber Howerton, Jerica Acord, John Xavier Norman-Sokoll, and Isaac Norman-Sokoll; and six great-grandchildren.
