Plymouth, MI — It is with deep sorrow, we announce the sudden passing of Bryan Eric Rupert, age 56, of Plymouth, Michigan. Bryan was born in Ann Arbor Michigan on April 10, 1969.

A 1988 graduate of Salem High School, Bryan was active in football and wrestling and was selected to be in the Talented and Gifted program. He went on to graduate from Ferris State University in 1993 with a Bachelor's Degree in Marketing and Advertising. While at Ferris, he was a proud member of Phi Sigma Kappa fraternity where he was honored as "Man of the Year." His entrepreneurial spirit emerged early, even during his college years.

Bryan built a remarkable career in sales and marketing, consistently rising to the top by exceeding goals and seizing every opportunity. Known as a true "go-getter," he once accepted a position with a tri-state sales target but was able to deliver those results in just the tri-county area. His career culminated in founding his own successful business in 2007. The company quickly became one of the leaders in electrical safety training and consulting, allowing Bryan to travel the world, often with his wife Kelly, sharing his expertise. His friends affectionately referred to these years as "the adventures of Bryan."

Above all, Bryan was a devoted husband and loyal friend. He married the love of his life, Kelly (DeVillez) Rupert, on July 15, 2005, in Ann Arbor. Together they shared 20 beautiful years of marriage filled with love, laughter, and countless adventures. They traveled extensively, often accompanied by their beloved dog Jack (or Lo-Lo), always eager to explore new places and create memories.

Bryan had a heart for helping others—frequently before they even asked and often without anyone knowing. He was a fantastic chef, visited friends in the hospital, and was known for sharing MAGA hats with “the guys at McDonald’s.” He deeply loved Kelly and was extremely close to her sister Debbie. She was a cherished part of their lives for many years when he was not only a brother-in-law but a care giver.

He will be remembered as someone who never backed down from a challenge and always found a way to exceed expectations, whether in business or in life.

Bryan is survived by his wife Kelly, his father Ronald, his beloved dog Jack, and many dear friends who were like family.
