She lived in Darby, PA. and attended Blessed Virgin Mary School to eighth grade, then on to West Philadelphia Catholic School for girls. She married Jim at BVM Church, 12-12-59.

Jim was in the Navy and she later joined him in the Philippines and her first time flying west from Philadelphia to Seattle, Tokyo and Manilla. Kay & Jim lived in a small town near Subic Bay and then lived on base housing. Her first child, Jim Jr. was born in the Philippines and we later were brought back to the U.S. by troop transport, carrying soldiers from S. Korea. They lived in Conshohocken, PA where Kay had David and Stephen. They then lived in Plymouth Twp., PA and Jim was transferred by Ford to Dearborn, MI. They lived in Plymouth, MI since 1976. Kay died May 21, 2021.

Kay found her calling by volunteering after the boys were raised. She volunteered at Angela Hospice 16 years, Plymouth Adult Day Care 16 years, West Trail Nursing Home 18 years, Meals on Wheels, delivering food 25 years, M on W office for 16 years Stephen Ministry, and communion to the sick for 13 years. Kay was a quiet angel on earth. She remained friends forever with her childhood girl friends from BVM School.
