We are sad to announce the passing of Chris Milo. Chris passed away Christmas Day in Glendora, CA at 89 years old with his loving wife of 63 years, Ruth, at his side. Chris was born in the village of Ljubojno, Macedonia on July 18, 1933. He was the third child, and only son, of Spase and Sandra Miloshevich. Chris moved to America in 1955. He met his wife on a blind date that same year and they went on to marry in 1959. In 1964, they welcomed their son, David, followed by their daughter Rebecca in 1966. Chris worked tirelessly to achieve his American Dream. You could always find him at one of his restaurants or at his bar (Sugar Shack) in Detroit. After marrying, Chris and Ruth lived in Detroit.
