Dave was rough and tough on the outside, but had a tender heart and I loved him. I remember sitting with him on the porch at Grandma’s when he told me about Barbara and their plans for marriage.

The whole family loved Barbara, the love of Dave’s life. We all grieved for Dave and the boys when she passed from this life. I sent Dave money for roses to put on her grave on the anniversary of her passing for a number of years.

The last three times I saw Dave were all happy occasions: at Shawn’s wedding, at Tommy’s wedding, and at a family get-together at Dena’s home. That would be the last time that his mother, my dear Aunt Pearl, and my Mom, Marge, would see each other in this life.
