She never missed a birthday, delighted in picking out the perfect gift featuring each child’s favorite character or activity, and treasured every cuddle she could get. Even in her later years, when she had grown a bit weaker, she was determined to soak up every hug, every smile, and every moment.

Pat was the loving sister of seven siblings. She was preceded in death by

Mary Hoyer, John Noone, Thomas Noone, and Annie Schroder, and is survived by Eileen Lindberg, William Noone, and Michael Noone. She was also dearly loved by many nieces, nephews, cousins, neighbors, and lifelong friends.

She grew up in Dearborn and graduated from Fordson High School in 1956. After marrying George, they began their family there, building friendships with neighbors that lasted more than 65 years. In 1972, she moved to the Plymouth-Canton area, where she planted roots in a community she would cherish for the next 54 years.

Pat worked locally in retail, where her beautiful sense of style and natural eye for fashion truly shined. She proudly helped open the first Meijer store in the community, forming friendships that continued well beyond her retirement. She didn't just enjoy working in retail — she loved supporting it. A perfect Sunday afternoon often meant window shopping, browsing both new stores and old favorites. She always knew exactly what was right for every holiday, celebration, and special occasion.

She was a gamer at heart. She loved watching *The Price Is Right*, playing cards or poker (always for a few cents or dollars), and could turn even a simple Bingo game into friendly competition. In her earlier years she enjoyed trips to Las Vegas; later, she was just as happy visiting local casinos — even venturing as far north as Michigan's Upper Peninsula. She especially loved learning new games from her grandchildren and, of course, her beloved GiGi crew.

A devoted Detroit sports fan, Pat rarely missed a Tigers, Lions, or Red Wings game if she could help it. Many evenings included a quick stop from one of her children to make sure the television was tuned to the right channel. She also treasured visits from Paws, especially during the holidays.

Above all else, time with family brought her the greatest happiness. Each of her children had their own designated night and hour to talk with her every week — a routine she treasured. To them she was Mom. To nine, she was Grandma Pat. And to the littlest ones who lit up her world, she was proudly

and forever GiGi.

Pat will be deeply missed by all who loved her. Her warmth, style, laughter, competitive spirit, and unwavering love — especially her love as GiGi — will live on in the hearts of her family for generations to come.
