Duane Kirk Briski, age 35 of Jenison, passed away February 1, 2008 at St. Mary's Hospital in Grand Rapids, where he had been a patient for several days. Duane was born October 10, 1972 in Southfield, the son of Paul and Gloria (Lassila) Briski. Duane grew up in Westland, where he attended the Wayne Westland schools and graduated from Wayne Memorial High School in 1990. Throughout his childhood, he loved sports and played on many local teams.



Duane was united in marriage to the former Cheryl Brown on June 7, 2002. He lived in Ypsilanti and Spring Lake, and since 2003 made his home in Jenison. Duane was employed by Carter Lumber for eight years and also Johnson Controls. Most recently, he was employed by Plastech, where he worked as a mold changer. Duane was passionate about carpentry, enjoyed working on his house and dreamed about one day building his own home. He continued to enjoy sports, county western music, deer hunting and debating politics and religion with anyone willing to take on the challenge. However, his most loved activity was being the proud father of his two children, Jessica and Brandon, whom he cherished more than anything else in this world.



Duane was preceded in death by his grandparents, Wilbert Lassila and Elaine (Lampinen) Lassila Maatta: his grandfather, Anton Briski, Jr., and an aunt, Rose (Lassila) Perala.
