After retirement, he was called back to the Boy's Club several times to serve in various capacities, and in 1999 was given the Lifetime honor of being named Director Emeritus. In 2001 ♦ "The Edmund A. Rommeck Professional of the Year Award" was created by the Boys and Girls Clubs of Southeastern Michigan, and bestowed in his name.
