Fr. Roger graduated from the University of Detroit with a business degree. He did several jobs but always felt he had a calling to serve God. His parishioners were a joy to him. He conducted healing services to help them. He enjoyed singing at mass and loved to make people smile.

Father Knapp was an ordained priest for the Archdiocese of Detroit on June 22, 1985. Father Roger Knapp served as Pastor of St. Victor Parish, Rockwood, and as Administrator of St. Michael Parish, Pontiac and St. Augustine Parish, Richmond. He also served as Parochial Vicar at St. Joan of Arc Parish, St. Clair Shores; St. Clement Parish, Warren; St. Theodore of Canterbury Parish, Westland; St. Rene Goupil Parish, Sterling Heights; and St. Patrick Parish, White Lake. Father Knapp also served the spiritual needs of the religious women at Mt. Thabor Monastery in Oxford Michigan. He will be missed!
