Like many immigrants of his era, George left his homeland for “The American Dream.” Without any formal culinary training, he became the Head Chef at Detroit’s famous Carl’s Chop House where he manned the grill for over 50 years into his late 70’s. George was a mainstay at Carl’s.

When he first “tried” to retire, his bosses refused to allow it. Over the years, he prepared meals for the who’s who of Detroit, including local politicians, judges, and UAW executives, all of whom, he had long standing relationships with. George was a beloved Husband, Father, Uncle, Papou & Friend who will be truly missed.

Surviving are his son, Perry Bouldas (Paraskevo); grand-daughters, Ioanna Bouldas and Zafaroula Bouldas; Great-grandson & the apple of his eye, Kane Michael Hreha; brother-in-law, Andreas Hatziantoniou.

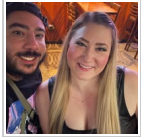
