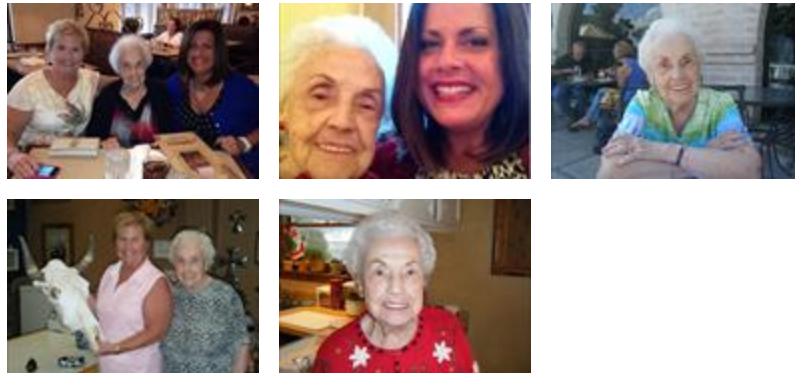

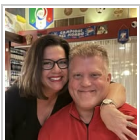
Cheryl, thinking of you and your family and sending my heartfelt condolences.
