Growing up, the kids can all remember the big sewing machine and boxes of pelts in the basement. To also help supplement the family income, she was a dress maker. Her hobbies were bingo, playing games, and fishing. She was afraid of water so wouldn't go out in a boat, but would fish from shore for hours. She always enjoyed family gatherings and at Christmas her house had so many lights on it, it was the brightest on the block. After a three-way bypass when she was 65 and a broken hip in her eighties she was still able to live independently until the age of 92. Janet is survived by her children, Frank (Yolanda) Wujcik, Diane Signorelli, Lonnie (Vicki) Wujcik, Patrick Wujcik, and Cynthia Wujcik. Janet has eleven grandchildren and numerous great and great great grandchildren. She was predeceased by her siblings, Leonard
