Her devotion to living out her Christian faith through her church, education and cultural activities was evident throughout her life. While her children were in elementary and secondary school, she was always an active PTA member, helped organize class field trips, and was an active fund raiser for numerous school activities. Outside the classroom, she helped to initiate the Junior Great Books program in both Dearborn and Plymouth, was a 4-H leader, active in Indian Princesses and initiated the "Close Up" program, which gives students an opportunity to experience a meaningful trip to Washington, D.C. She always could be counted on to take

an active role in programs and activities that would enrich the education experience for her children and their classmates. Janet also was active in adding value to the community of Plymouth. She was instrumental in organizing the Plymouth Canton Community Literacy Council, the Plymouth Arts Council, Music in the Park, and planning for the new public library building. She also helped to bring Peter Rockwell to Plymouth, where he was commissioned to create marble play sculptures for children in Plymouth Township Park. While family was always paramount, Janet's passing also will leave a void in the lives of many dear friends. May she rest in peace.
