You also told me that you cut them up and put them in a bucket in a coal mine. One of your sisters said that you hitched a ride and stabbed a guy while he was driving. I just checked my credit. Looks like you bought a house and car in my name and let it go into foreclosure and repoed. Thanks Isaac and Diane. Nothing like using your own kids social security card to take advantage of their credit. Who cares if they actually want to use their credit to live their life. One day I was walking to work and it was winter. I felt you come to me and say you are sorry. I said I sort of understand that you were caught up in the human condition. Its not for me to judge. I forgive because I cant hold onto the grudges and hate I have for you Isaac. Then a week later, I got phone calls that you died. You were a nightmare and hurt so many, you got off easy dying from a heart attack. The only thing that was good about you is I'm a tough woman who can survive most anything because you were an abusive alcoholic it inspired me to never drink. Taught me to be kind and follow the law. I maybe good cause you were not. We all have life contracts before we come. I'm hoping your role as a murderer and an asshole and abuser is done and you can incarnate into someone much happier and healthier. Good luck on your path Isaac, I'm sure its warm where you are now.
