Jeffrey L. Boler was born October 27, 1959 in Detroit to Alex and Dorothy Mae Cureton- Boler. He passed away on July 14, 2007 at St. Mary Mercy Hospital In Livonia, Michigan. A Funeral service will be held on Thursday at 11:00 AM at Greater Grace Temple 23500 W. 7 Mile, Detroit.. A family hour will be from 10:30 until the time of the service. Visitation will be at Vermeulen Funeral Home, 46401 W. Ann Arbor Road, Plymouth (Between Sheldon and Beck) on Wednesday from 6:00 until 8:00 PM. Interment will be at Grand Lawn Cemetery in Detroit.

Jeffery graduated as an honor student from Detroit Chadsey High School. While there he majored in Auto Design and Carpentry, which led to his selection for the apprenticeship program at Milford Fabrication Company in Detroit, where he subsequently received a certification in Tool & Die making, and later graduated from Henry Ford College with a Bachelor's degree in Computer-Aided Drafting.

A hit and run car accident on November 26, 1988 left Jeffrey missing for one week. He was later found in Sinai Grace Hospital where he underwent several surgeries and was comatose for two years. ❖ He was diagnosed as a quadriplegic Spinal Cord & Closed Head injury Patient. The injury may have claimed his body, but not his spirit and his will to live. ❖ Jeff lived over nineteen years after the accident. ❖ His inspiration for life was the foundation

for the creation of the family business, Star Home Care Services, Inc. Jeffrey's legacy has bonded the family and will live on for generations to come.

Jeffrey attended Star of Zion Missionary Baptist Church with his mother under the leadership of Pastor Walter Baker. ♦ He later attended Greater Grace Temple under Bishop Charles Ellis with his sister Gloria. ♦ He loved bowling, sports, soap operas, his time at Special Tree and working with his occupational therapist, Kathy Grace.

Jeffrey leaves to cherish his memory his two children - Jeffrey Rasool of Detroit and Brandy Boler of Kansas. Also his father Alex (Anita L.) Boler of Indiana: his sister and caregiver Gloria (James ) Dunlap: six brothers: James (Nykoa) Boler of Georgia, Tyrone (Peggy) Boler of Florida, Michael (Anita R. ) Boler , Cordell, Cornell and Gregory Boler Sr., all of Detroit. He also leaves behind a host of aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
