



Jennifer Lynn Whitteaker

September 5, 1969 - March 18, 2025

Jennifer Lynn Whitteaker, age 55, of Plymouth, Michigan, passed away on March 18, 2025, surrounded by her loving family.

Born in Vineland, New Jersey, on September 5, 1969, Jennifer was the cherished daughter of Mila and Danny Sarsozo. She was raised in Canton, Michigan, where she began a life rooted in faith, family, and perseverance. She attended St. Raphael Primary School, graduated from Ladywood High School in 1987, and continued her education at the University of Michigan, earning her bachelor's degree in 1991. She later completed her master's degree at Michigan State University, a reflection of her lifelong dedication to learning.

On May 21, 1994, Jennifer married Scott D. Whitteaker in Canton. Their partnership of more than 30 years was marked by love, strength, and devotion—a bond that remained unshakable through life's many seasons. Together, they raised two children, Jack and Sophia, who were the heart of Jennifer's world.

Jennifer devoted more than three decades to DTE Energy, where she began as a customer service representative and rose through the ranks to become a Regional Manager. Her leadership was defined by integrity, quiet determination, and genuine care for those around her. She was deeply respected by her colleagues and made a lasting imprint on the organization. Beyond her professional life, Jennifer gave generously of her time and energy to causes close to her heart. She was an active member of St. John Neumann

Catholic Church in Canton. She served as Treasurer of the Southern Wayne County Regional Chamber, Vice-Chair of the Troy Chamber of Commerce, Secretary of the Transportation Improvement Association, and sat on the Board of Trustees for the Detroit Symphony Orchestra—an institution whose music she treasured.

Jennifer's joys were found in the simple moments: the rhythm of dancing, the soul of live music, the sweetness of dessert, and the quiet comfort of crocheting. With each stitch, she wove warmth into the lives of others. She had a gift for making people feel seen, heard, and loved.

She leaves behind her devoted husband, Scott; her loving children, Jack (Riley) and Sophia (Alex); and her granddaughter, Delilah, who brought her immeasurable joy. She is also survived by her mother, Mila, her siblings, Patrick (Michelle) and Jessica (Charles), and by many dear friends and extended family whose lives were enriched by her presence.

Visitation will be held on Monday, March 24, from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM, and Tuesday, March 25, from 1:00 PM to 9:00 PM, with a Rosary Service at 6:00 PM at Vermeulen-Sajewski Funeral Home, 46401 Ann Arbor Road West (between Sheldon and Beck), Plymouth. Jennifer will lie in state on Wednesday, March 26, at 10:30 AM until the Funeral Mass at 11:00 AM at St. John Neumann Catholic Church, 44800 Warren Road, Canton.

Interment will follow at Glen Eden Memorial Park in Livonia.
