With a sad and heavy heart, we announce the passing of Jerry Arnold Hotchkin on July 11, 2021 after his long struggle with Alzheimer's Disease. Jerry was born on June 15th, 1939 and lived in Plymouth, Michigan, all his life. His parents were George and Harriet Hotchkin, with siblings Gene Hotchkin and Janet Blaesing. He loved playing and watching golf, and was overjoyed to see his own children and grandchildren take an interest as well. As a young married man, he owned a boat and was an accomplished water skier. For a brief period later in life, he even rode motorcycles.

Jerry was dedicated and supportive of his children and granddaughters. To Jerry and Elaine, he was active as a baseball and basketball coach, as well as founder and active participant of the Plymouth Music Boosters. In addition, he

provided many family road trips to the beaches of Florida for family vacation. Jerry and Lois traveled across the country for numerous summers together, and were the most dedicated fans at their granddaughters' softball games. Jerry loved his family, and was always there as a loving husband, caring father, and proud grandfather.
