



## Joseph Ronald Gregoire

December 14, 1943 - January 17, 2024

Joseph Ronald Gregoire, 80, of Westland, Michigan died on Wednesday, January 17, 2024, in his home surrounded by his family. His family includes his beloved wife of 56 years Patricia. Loving father of Steve (Billie) Gregoire and Sheryl (Rob) Hutton. Proud grandfather of Elizabeth “Libby” and Robert “Tripp”. Dear brother of Diana Wells and Sandy (Louis) Zomparelli. He also leaves many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, Virgil and Dorothy Gregoire, Brothers David (Diane) Gregoire, Phillip (Yvonne) Gregoire, and Charles Gregoire. Joseph was born December 14, 1943, in Wyandotte, MI and grew up in Lincoln Park, MI. He graduated from Holy Redeemer High School in Detroit, MI. Upon graduation he was employed by Whitehead and Kales before enlisting in the United States Air Force. After a year of training, he was stationed for two years in Japan. After being discharged from the Air Force he attended RETS – National Institute of Technology and graduated as an electronic technician. He also graduated from Irene’s Myomas ology Institute and performed massage therapy in addition to his regular job. He liked to make people feel good both emotionally and physically. He was a highly active Boy Scout until his death. He joined the Boy Scouts of America in 1951 as a cub scout and advanced to the Boy Scouts to earn the highest rank, that of Eagle Scout, in 1958. Along this path he also earned the Harvey S. Firestone Jr. award for being an outstanding Scout and was a member of the Order of the Arrow. He spent 57 years in the Boy Scout program helping boys and girls to learn the skills of life and

mentoring those scouts who wanted to achieve the Eagle Rank by helping them earn the required merit badges. He took boys to many states camping and doing high adventure. The boys went to the National Scout Jamboree and spent a week at the Philmont National Scout Ranch in Cimmaron, New Mexico. He worked with scouts from all around the world when he was on staff for the Michigan International Camporee in addition to being an Assistant Scoutmaster while he served in the Air Force in Japan. Joe liked to try to make things better. As a result, he was an inventor of the Coupon Caddy which he patented in 1991 and sold through the company he created, JPG Novelty. He worked for several companies before being employed by Design Systems, Inc. in 1988. He retired after 21 years in 2009. Spending time with his grandchildren was his greatest joy. He also liked to hunt, garden, camp, travel and being in nature. Getting together with friends and playing cards were things he especially liked to do after he retired. He will be missed by many.
