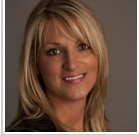


Hi Chuckie!!! My dad still talked you all the time 💜 He would tell me how mad your mom would get at him because he corrupted her son.

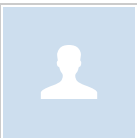
