Joseph Herbert Winebrener, age 91 of Westland, Michigan, formerly of Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, died July 1, 2007. Mr. Winebrener was born in Walkersville MD on September 5, 1915, the second child of Herbert and Marie (Gunn) Winebrener. He was baptized, and grew up in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, where he graduated from Rothsville High School in 1934.
