Karamjeet Singh Khangura, age 68, passed away suddenly and peacefully on October 3rd, 2025, in his elder brother's arms at his house in Chicago. Karamjeet was a beautiful soul, simple, honest, and straightforward family man. He was full of life and laughter, with his beautiful charm and wit telling jokes all the time, well-liked by everyone and was a good singer. He was loving and a devoted husband and father with unconditional love towards his wise and beautiful wife and his two smart and beautiful daughters.

He was the beloved son of the late Sardar Ajaib Singh and Sardarni Surjit Kaur Khangura. A devoted son, Karamjeet passionately cared for his parents to the end of their lives in Ludhiana India embodying unconditional LOVE and compassion. He was such a dedicated and devoted son, that Karamjeet moved to Ludhiana in 2017 and lived there for 5 plus years to take care of his father till his death on January 14, 2022. He loved his elder brother dearly (they were like two peas in a pod).

His family moved from Village Taipur and Rottowal to Ludhiana where his father was a "gazette officer" for Punjab Government. Karamjeet was born in Rattowal, Punjab, India. He was the youngest of 2 boys and grew up in Ludhiana. He earned a Law degree from Lucknow University and became a licensed and practicing Advocate in Ludhiana at Chamber No. 617 with a prestigious law partner. He was well liked and respected by his colleagues

and the “District Bar Association Ludhiana”, who are holding a PATH (Sikh prayer) in his honor at a Gurdwara in Ludhiana.

In the beginning of 1987, Karamjeet was introduced to Rupinder Saran and they were married on April 5th, 1987. Karamjeet migrated to the USA in 1989 along with his wife Rupinder and daughter Navneet to join his elder brother Kanwaljit (Kuki) in Metropolitan Detroit. Their first daughter, Navneet, was born in Ludhiana and the second daughter, Gagneet in Dearborn, Michigan.

Karamjeet will be missed excessively by all the people who came across him; family, relatives, friends, neighbors, colleagues who are devastated and shocked by his sudden death and mourn his loss. He leaves behind a hole that can never be filled, but his family and friends find comfort in his good and beautiful jokes and memories and that he has reunited with his mother and father in heaven with the grace of Satguru (God).
