Kathleen “Kathy” Payne Bellamy, 81, of Canton MI, died at home on Thursday, November 21, 2024.

She was born on August 8, 1943, in Ogdensburg, NY, where she attended local schools before continuing her education at the State University of New York at Canton. 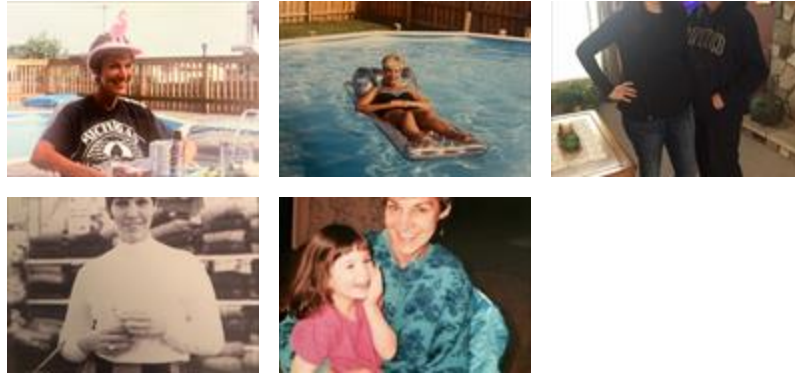
