Laurence Stanley Gregory of Northville, MI passed away November 29, 2025, aged 70, at Kinwell Senior Living in South Lyon.

Larry was the son of the late Marian and Bill Gregory and grew up in Bay City, Michigan. He received a bachelor of science from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor and was self-employed as a civil engineer. He frequently worked alongside his father at Gregory Construction Co. and enjoyed using his engineering abilities to help friends and relatives complete projects. He also led the design and build of the homes he shared with his wife, Nancy, and their daughter, Liz. Larry conducted business from a home office and found ultimate fulfillment as a stay-at-home dad; he was forever Liz's truest friend, ally, and advocate.

He enjoyed Detroit Tigers baseball and Michigan football, snow skiing, fly-fishing, cooking, working outdoors, attending classic car shows, summers at Torch Lake, and sharing cheeseburgers with his beloved dog, Yuma.

Larry was diagnosed with Parkinson's in 2004 and lived with the disease to the best of anyone's ability for over two decades. His family is immensely proud of his perseverance and his continued ability to care for others despite his own hardship. He will be remembered for his unwavering sense of duty, genuine kindness, quiet generosity, and sense of humor.

He is survived by his daughter, Liz, and his son-in-law, Dan. He is also survived by his sister, Cindy, sister-in-law, Nitsa, sister-in-law Sandy (Larry), and nieces and nephews, Andy, Billy, Cody, Keely, Bronson, Esme, Josh, and Drew. He was preceded in death by his wife, Nancy, his parents, Marian and Bill, his brother, David, his parents-in-law Don and Eleanor, and his brother-in-law, Tim.
