July 21, 1921 - May 31, 2011

Lucille Irene Briski, 89, of Garden City, passed away May 31, 2011, at Pontiac Osteopathic Hospital, where she had been a patient for several days. Lucille was born July 21, 1921, in Reedsburg, Wisconsin, the daughter of the late Clifford and Lilvie (Stowell) Stombaugh, and was raised in Reedsburg. Lucille was united in marriage to Anton Briski, Jr. on December 24, 1943. She and Anton resided in Trimountain throughout their married life. After Anton's death in 1997, she made her home at Arbor Green in Houghton. Since 2006, Lucille has lived in Garden City with her son and daughter-in-law, Paul & Gloria Briski, spending her weekends with her son Curtis in Pontiac. Lucille spent most of her early years as a homemaker and later was employed in the housekeeping department at Cypress Manor in Hancock for 16 years, retiring in 1989. She was also active in the Jeffers High School Music Parents Association during the 1970's. Over the years, Lucille loved to cook and bake, work crossword puzzles, go on shopping outings, take walks with friends and watch Wheel of Fortune and Jeopardy. Breakfasts and lunches out with family and playing Scrabble also gave her much enjoyment. Most recently, she took great pleasure with her four great grandchildren, whom she adored, and her two 'grand cats', Zoe and Maggie, who provided her with many hours of wonderment and amazement. In addition to her parents and husband, Lucille was preceded in death by her sister, Vera Jeannotte; her brother, Milton Stombaugh; her grandsons, Stephen Briski and Duane Briski; her niece, Shirley Jeannotte; and her nephew, Michael Stombaugh. Lucille is survived by
