To help pay for her many lessons and costumes, Marcia taught

dance to several groups of beginning students. She arranged fun and elaborate recitals and even performed in many of them herself. As a teenager, she won several medals for her skill in pairs roller skating. Later, she and Bill enjoyed square and round dancing together. She loved line dancing with her friends and continued dancing several times a week right up until January of this year.

Marcia attended Northridge Church, where she volunteered by preparing mailings for prisoners and bulletins for services. Her favorite position, though, was acting as a greeter, warmly and enthusiastically welcoming each person who entered through her door.

Marcia's endless energy and passion will be missed by all who knew her. For those who knew her well and miss her the most, it takes only a moment of reflection to picture her as she is now, dancing gracefully in Heaven.
