With heavy hearts, our family announces the passing of Meredith Suzanne Conte, our beloved daughter, sister, auntie, niece and cousin, who left this world far too soon on September 19, 2025, at the age of 49.

Meredith was known for her joyful nature, her boundless compassion and selflessness, and her unwavering devotion to those she loved. Love was the cornerstone of her life, and she extended genuine warmth and affection to everyone she met - and of course to any dog that crossed her path.

Meredith had a true connection with animals of all kinds, especially dogs. Her love for animals brought her into homes across the state where people trusted her to care for their pets. She loved each and every furry friend she made as if they were her own. She also had a deep and abiding love for pandas, although sadly she never fulfilled her lifelong dream to cuddle one.

Community engagement was another of Meredith's many passions. She was an active member and corresponding secretary of the American Association of University Women (AAUW) Plymouth-Canton Branch. The Branch provides

live drama for children to benefit the association's scholarships for women pursuing higher education. Meredith was a shining star in many of these productions; her roles included Peter Pan, Toto, and the White Rabbit. Her favorite role was the Beast.

Meredith's fun-loving nature led her on many adventures with friends across the country. Whether following her favorite band, visiting her favorite characters at Disney parks, hiking in Yosemite, walking across the Mackinac Bridge, or chasing eclipses, Meredith delighted in exploring and enjoying the world. She also relished sharing meals and drinks with friends, and quiet moments of deep connection.

Meredith worked in retail for many years, but found her true professional home at the University of Michigan Medical School's Department of Internal Medicine in the Division of Gastroenterology and Hepatology, where she worked as an administrative assistant. She loved her work supporting those who heal and care for people, and she loved her colleagues, many of whom became close friends.

Meredith is survived and greatly missed by her parents Mike and Gail Conte, her siblings Marisa Conte (Tim Neville), Kevin (Jill) Conte and Kyle Conte (Amber Zmick), beloved nieces and nephews Drake, Talia, Liam, Zoe and Charlie, and by many loving aunts, uncles and cousins. She is preceded in death by her grandparents Leonard and Jean Conte, and Brian and Dorothy Honeyball, and by her aunts Mary Swander and Suzanne Timberlake.

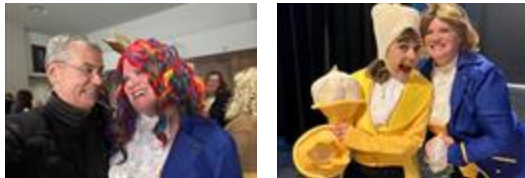
