Michael James Geoghegan, M.D. passed away on May 5, 2020, surrounded by his beloved family. Born on May 19, 1936 in Detroit and proudly raised by Irish immigrant parents, Mike was the youngest of six children. He graduated from Colgate University (NY) and Wayne State University School of Medicine. After completing his orthopedic residency at Detroit Medical Center, Mike served in Vietnam and earned a Bronze Star. Upon his return, he trained many orthopedic residents studying at Wayne State, to mutual benefit. He married Leslie Joanne Luke in 1974 and raised two children, Michael Edward and Daniel. Mike enjoyed a 40-year career in orthopedic surgery, primarily serving at Oakwood Hospital. He was preceded in death by his parents Michael and Margaret; and siblings Thomas (Patricia), William, Daniel, and Joan Van Riper. Mike will be deeply missed by his wife Leslie; sons Michael (Rebecca) and Daniel (Christine); grandchildren Seamus, Daniel, Michael, Joseph, Catherine, Anna, and Clare; sister Rita (Paul) Jeakle; sister-in-law Margaret Geoghegan; and countless nieces, nephews, and friends. I was taken to the hospital and Dr. Geoghegan was my surgeon. He did a procedure where he wired my ankle together. As we spoke, we found out that we were both from SW Detroit. (He grew up on Wendel and I on Springwell street.) Doc took great care of me and we became friends. After our tours were over, we both returned to MI. I was injured in an accident in the Ford Steel Division, circa 1978 and needed knee surgery. Since it was a compensation case, FOMOCO sent me to Dearborn Orthopedics and to my surprise, Dr. Geoghegan was once again my doctor.
