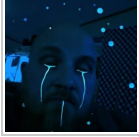

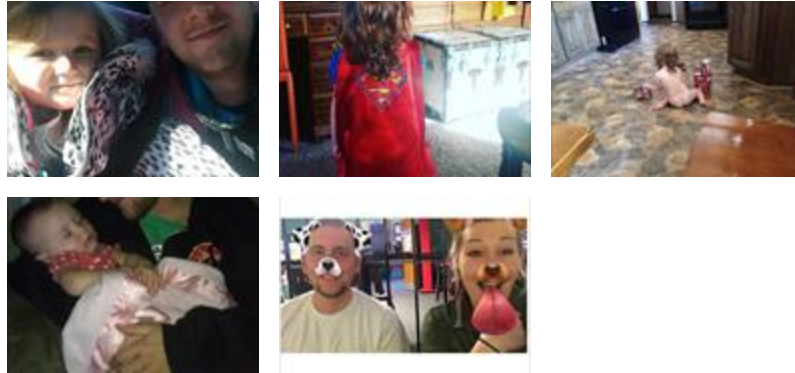
You will be so sadly missed Pat..Don't worry I got the dish washing for ya.... Love you kiddo. You are very special, more than you know.
