Paul A. Pendracki, age 69, passed away peacefully on September 23, 2025. Born on November 24, 1955, Paul was the beloved son of the late Joseph S. and Dorothy H. Pendracki. A devoted son, Paul cared for both of his parents at the end of their lives, embodying compassion and dedication to family. He was also preceded in death by his brother, David Pendracki, and sister-in-law, Amy Pendracki.

Paul grew up with a love for sports and served as a team manager for multiple high school teams during his time at Bishop Borgess High School. He continued his education at Schoolcraft Community College and Lawrence Technological University.

On April 1, 1982, Paul began his career with Wayne County, where he worked at Warren Valley Golf Course, Construction, Norton Yard, and the Sign Shop. Through hard work and commitment, he advanced from laborer to equipment operator, foreman, and eventually supervisor. He was actively involved with Local 101 and later Local 1862, the foreman's union. Paul strongly believed in the importance of union participation and was proud to represent and advocate for retirees. After 27 years of service, he retired in 2009.

Paul was a faithful member of Our Lady of Victory Catholic Church. A lifelong sports enthusiast, he was especially passionate about hockey and remained a devoted Detroit Red Wings fan since childhood.
