Ralph Leo Fisher, affectionately known as “Pops” and “Papa,” passed away peacefully on May 17, 2025, in Ann Arbor, Michigan, at the age of 82.

Born on March 3, 1943, in Cadillac, Michigan, Ralph was the beloved son of Alonzo and Florence Christina Fisher (née Hansen). One of Ralph's proudest hobbies was "Fisher Racing," a family tradition he shared with his son, brothers, and nephews. He thrived on the excitement of the track and the camaraderie that came with it.

Perhaps his favorite tradition of all was hosting the Annual Pig Roast. It was a true highlight of the year, when family and friends brought their campers and gathered for a weekend full of celebration, food, and togetherness.
