He had a very outgoing personality and a wonderful sense of humor. As a young man he played clarinet in his grandfather's Czech band and met his wife Charlotte when he came to take voice lessons from her in Detroit. He had a good voice and took part in many of the shows she put on. Mr. Viculin was an excellent dancer and he and Charlotte were often asked if they were professionals. He was a medic in WWII. Mr. Viculin received a Purple Heart and the Bronze Star for pulling wounded soldiers out of a burning ambulance while injuring himself in Germany. He was a member of Patton's 3rd Armored Division. He is entered in the WWII Registry of Remembrance at the National Memorial in Washington D.C. Mr. Viculin went to Michigan State University after the war and became a Special Agent for Prudential Life Insurance Company of America, where he worked for 39 years winning several awards along the way.
