With over 60 patents in his name, Roberts most notable invention was the electric outside rearview automobile mirror, and memory seat/memory mirrors. He also designed tuck away windshield wipers as well as the rear end leveling suspension system for Cadillacs. He worked for Cadillac Motor co. in research and development for 20 years. Later worked in research and development for Harmon International. Left Harmon, and Patented and manufactured the first Electric power pack for outside review mirrors as Robert Fisher Enterprises, Inc., Also patented the first breakaway mirror as well as many other accomplishments. Robert raised 8 children with love, understanding, and the utmost of moral standards. He coached two baseball players who went on to major league baseball. Coached all of his sons, and many neighborhood children in the Barney McKowski Baseball league. Robert was extremely generous in giving to those who were not as fortunate as himself. His greatest joy as he got older was spending time at home with his life long partner and best friend Corinne of 57 years, his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. He loved to be surrounded by children.
