

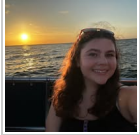


Sally Jane Coffman

She always made me feel special and loved.

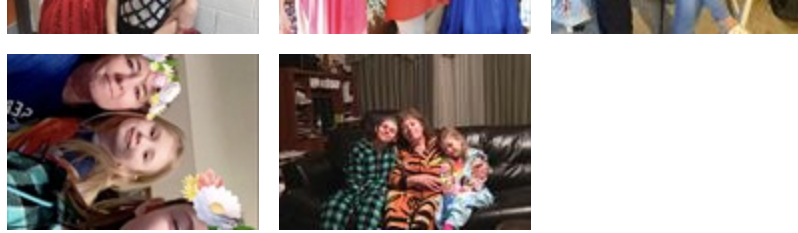
