Shannon Mae Kozlowski, age 25, passed away Tuesday, March 2, 2021 in Camp Pendleton, CA. Shannon was born January 27, 1996 in Farmington, Michigan to loving parents, Mark Kozlowski and Ellen Ball.

Shannon grew up in Canton, MI where she attended Canton High School and Washtenaw Community College. While attending school, Shannon enjoyed many activities, including volleyball and dance, but Shannon's greatest interest and passion was gymnastics.

Shannon joined the United States Marine Corps in March 2016, where she served honorably until her death. During her time in the Marines, Shannon was stationed and resided in Yuma, AZ, where she met and married her husband Logan Kram. While she was in Yuma, Shannon found time to assistant coach the cheerleading team at a local high school. In January 2020, Shannon was transferred to the Marine base in Okinawa, Japan where she served until February 2021.

Shannon also had a great love for animals, and was a wonderful mother and caregiver to her three dogs, Kevin, Riley, and Hara, and two cats, Fish and Marbles. 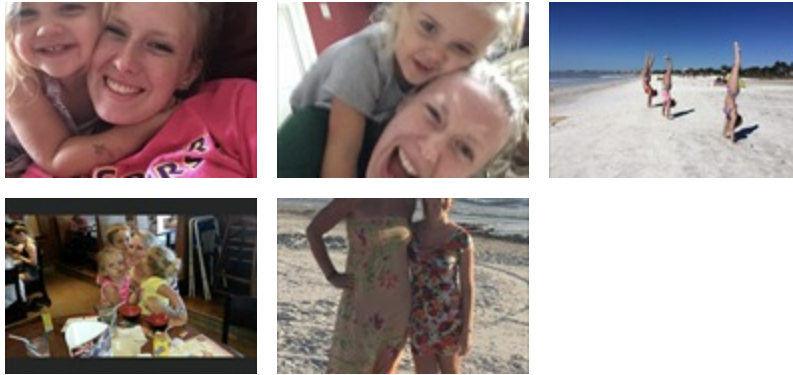

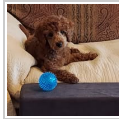
