Sherry Lynn Deremo Nadon, age 52, passed away unexpectedly at her home in Plymouth on Sunday, March 27. She was a loving mother, wife, daughter, sister, aunt, and sister-in-law, who was much loved and will be missed by her family, friends, colleagues, and her students at Rosedale Elementary in Livonia. 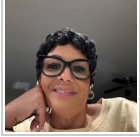

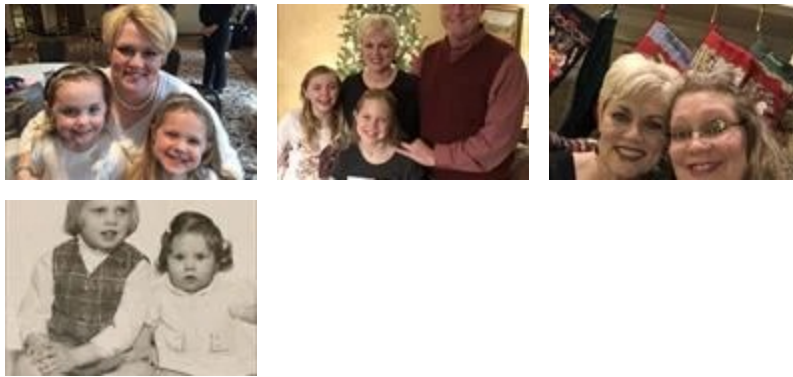

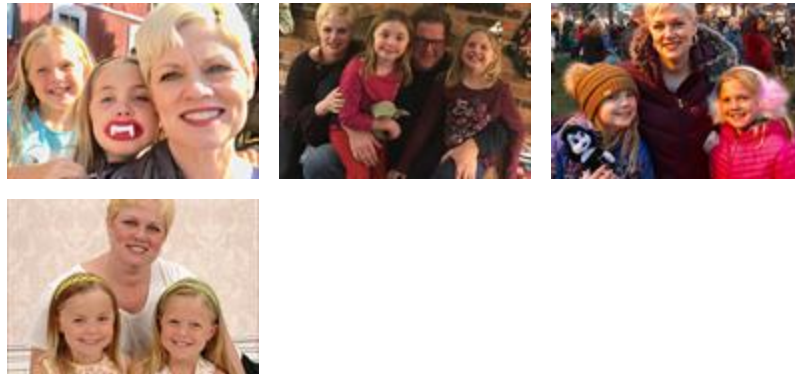
