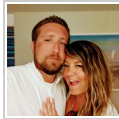

Like this year and the decades before, fate and circumstance, winds and rains will edit and erode so much of what shaped our life. Deep friendships remain. Deep connections endure.

They just hang on, coming up for air every 10 to 20 thousand moments or so.
