Thurlow Miller died April 12, 2016 at his home in Naples FL, he formerly lived in Westland MI.

Thurlow was born April 3, 1923 in Flint MI. He enlisted in the US Navy at the age of 17, and honorably served for 5 years on the Battleship USS Arkansas during World War II. He traveled around the world during his service in the Navy. The USS Arkansas is memorialized in a beautiful display case in the Naples Airport. After the war, he was employed as Tool & Die Maker at Burroughs in Plymouth MI. He retired in 1980 after 34 years of service. During his retirement, he spent many days with 50-100 other WWII veterans at the Homer Helter Antique Mall in Naples, where they shared stories and coffee. He is survived by his daughter Linda (Richard) Garrett and by his late son Eugene (Flor) Miller. He is the proud grandfather of Chris (Steve) Nash, Rick (Colleen) Garrett, Michael Miller and Steve (Kerry) Miller and great-grandfather Kyle (Kristy) Nash, Ryan Nash, Tara (Matt) Moore, Casey and Haley Miller.
